Please submit your AAA application by the dates below to ensure proper review the application is for League/Association use only, AYF will not accept paper applications for AAA nominations, they must be done online after League/Association verification is performed:

- AAA applications due to your conference board by November15th, 2017 for verification or an early date set forth by the local association or league.
- Association/League administrators MUST log-in to myayf.com and electronically submit all verified applicants with a 96% or Higher Average by February 1st, 2018. Paper Applications will not be accepted they are for Association/League Verification use only.
- AYF will announce all AAA award recipients in June 2018.

AAA recipients are chosen on the basis of academic achievement as well as extra-curricular activities and awards. All AAA recipients will receive a certificate to mark their achievement. A selection of exceptional students will receive a scholarship reward ranging from \$500-\$2,000.
